

Cockroach Baiting Only Preparation Sheet

It is essential that customers properly prepare the areas for successful service delivery. The following steps must be completed before we will perform a cockroach baiting-only treatment.



THESE TASKS LISTED MUST BE COMPLETE BEFORE OUR ARRIVAL:

- **PEANUT AND SHELLFISH ALLERGIES:** Some materials used for controlling cockroaches contain allergens (e.g. peanut butter and shellfish). Please notify your technician if you have food allergies.
- Make sure cabinets and pantry areas in the kitchen are organized and placed away from the cabinet doors to allow enough access and space for technicians to bait.
- Clean and clear countertops in the kitchen.
- Seal all food that is in cabinets or any other area into containers.
- Remove all items from under the sinks.
- Clean crumbs and spills from the counters or areas listed above to eliminate competing food sources.
- Keep all items in the same room - do not relocate items to another room – to prevent infestation of other areas.
- Remove trash from the home.
- Make sure cabinets and drawers in restrooms are organized in a way that provides technicians access to treatment areas.
- If there are roach problems in the bedrooms, furnace rooms, living room or any other room, then do make sure treatment areas are accessible.
- It will not be necessary to leave the home during treatment. Pets can also remain in the home.

AFTER TREATMENT IS COMPLETE:

- You may place back all the kitchen items you moved.
- Do not use pesticides of any kind on or around the treated areas, as this will counter Moore Quality treatment efforts and affect service guarantee.
- Keep cabinets and pantry areas in the kitchen organized.
- Keep all food that is in cabinets or any other area in sealed containers to remove competing sources.
- Keep countertops clean and clear of food and food crumbs.
- Clean any spills that happen right away.
- Keep garbage in a covered trash can and take it out regularly.
- You may notice increased roach activity/mobility for 1-2 days, as roaches leave their hiding areas to feed on bait. This activity will reduce over 2-4 weeks until eliminated.
