

Pantry Pest Treatment Preparation Instructions (Residential)



The purpose of these preparation instructions is to provide for the best opportunity to rid your environment of the infestation you are now experiencing. Strict adherence to these preparations is a must. Failure to prepare properly limits the effectiveness of the treatment(s) and will require additional treatments and more inconvenience to you. **The property needs to be ready prior to our appointment time. If you are not able to be prepared please contact the office prior to appointment time to discuss rescheduling when you will be able to be prepared. IF TECH ARRIVES WITHOUT THE PROPER PREPARATIONS COMPLETE BY CUSTOMER, APPOINTMENT WILL BE RESCHEDULED AND A \$50 FEE WILL BE BILLED TO YOU FOR OUR TRIP CHARGE.**

Preparations prior to arrival:

- All cabinets must be completely empty. (Upper cabinets as well as lower cabinets.)
- All items must be removed from the tops of counters AND cabinets.
- Pantry must be completely emptied.
- Do not store items removed from cabinet/pantry in same room that is to be treated.
- All food must be removed from the kitchen. (Except food stored in the refrigerator)
- You MUST vacate your premises for two hours.
- ALL INFESTED FOOD MUST BE THROWN AWAY.
- ALL FOOD NOT INFESTED MUST BE SEALED IN AIR TIGHT CONTAINERS. (Plastic bowls, glass jars, plastic bags, etc;)
