

Rodent Treatment Preparation Sheet

Please do not remove rodent droppings from any areas before inspection, as technician will need to gauge the level of activity. However, following steps must be completed before we will perform a rodent treatment.



THESE TASKS LISTED MUST BE COMPLETE BEFORE OUR ARRIVAL:

- Remove all dishes, pots, pans, cans, food and other items from ground level cupboards and drawers in the kitchen.
- Remove all items for restroom cabinets, drawers and vanity cabinets.
- Remove any obstructions to the attic access door.
- In the garage, remove items that are on the ground against the wall and remove vehicles from the garage.
- Clear the laundry room from items around the laundry machines.
- Remove any obstructions to the electrical panels, furnace units and air conditioning units.

AFTER TREATMENT IS COMPLETE:

- Do not move any of the traps or bait stations
- Do not use other products to treat rodents yourself, as this may counter Moore Quality's efforts to bring the problem under control. Rodents are intelligent creatures that learn to avoid traps/stations becoming "trap shy."
- Follow through with recommendations from the technician to rodent proof your property. Otherwise, new rodents will enter the property and services will not be effective.
- Put away food, keep areas clean of food crumbs and seal food in containers to remove food sources that compete with bait placed in traps/stations.
- Remove dog and cat food every night and keep food supply in tightly sealed containers to remove competing food.
- Keep indoor and outdoor trash cans closed and empty trash cans regularly.
- Your technician will schedule follow-up appointments to monitor and remove rodents. In between visits, please feel free to contact your technician directly if you see a rodent caught in a trap/station.
